Introduction

The real impact is hope.

Individuals and families say they are “relieved” when they find the Center for Grieving Children.

First, a staff member helps determine how best to help immediately. Often, what’s most needed is significant support by phone, or a referral to individual counseling or other assistance. If it seems the family may be ready to join one of our weekly peer support groups, the Center schedules a family interview.

At the Center, families find a safe place to talk about their personal experiences of loss and grief. They can speak their minds, without facing judgment. They find support that helps them understand and accept their loss and their feelings.

They tell us they feel less alone. They tell us the Center helps them find hope.

Impact*

- Spoke individually with 986 people to hear their stories and determine what information, support, and referrals would be most appropriate and helpful.
- For 60% of those who contacted us, it was a friend, family member, or Center volunteer or participant recommended the Center.

From the Executive Director

No Place Like It.

There’s no place in Maine like the Center for Grieving Children. No place but the Center is entirely devoted to supporting grieving children and families. Our services are free, for everyone, for as long as people want support.

These pages highlight the Center’s leadership and community impact during our 2010-11 fiscal year, a time when a busy place got even busier.

Calls for help from the Center have nearly doubled in less than two years. At the same time as our reputation for extraordinary service continues to grow, families’ options for information and service have become fewer. Wide-ranging cuts to health, social, and school services have made the support the Center gives even more critically important, now and for the foreseeable future.

Because loss isn’t going away—and there is devastating loss to a family when a loved one dies. Every member of the family experiences immediate and long-lasting impacts. Emotional and financial upheaval can be severe.

As the Center celebrates its 25th anniversary in 2012, we will look back to salute our founder, Bill Hemmens, and others who helped launch and grow the Center.

Looking ahead, we want Maine families to be able to continue relying on the Center as a resource. And we know that the Center’s leadership, combined with the generosity of individuals, businesses, foundations, and others, will make that possible.

Impact

- Families sought our services recently because a parent, child, or other family member died from: cancer (27%), suicide (15%), heart disease (11%), or an accident (12%).
- Of the families accessing our Tender Living Care (TLC) program, 70% reported a cancer diagnosis within their family.



Why Grief Support?

More than one in seven American children and teenagers experience the death of their parent, brother, or sister. For additional young people, a “parental figure,” often a grandparent or caregiver, dies.

Research tells us that children who receive reliable and appropriate support at this difficult time are less likely to: suffer anxiety or depression, die by suicide, abuse alcohol and drugs, and have problems in school.

But sustained grief support is rarely available—not through hospitals, palliative care programs, or even hospice programs. In a new study by the National Alliance for Grieving Children and the New York Life Foundation, grieving parents report overwhelmingly that there are not enough resources to help them or their children.

By providing support for Maine families, and taking a leading role in training people to provide grief support nationwide, the Center for Grieving Children is working to change that.



Our Core Programs

Bereavement Peer Support in Portland and Sanford, bringing together children, teens, parents, young adults, and adults—all of whom have experienced the death of someone close to them.

Tender Living Care, for families facing serious illness, from the point of diagnosis.

Multicultural Peer Support, serving refugee and immigrant Maine students from war-torn countries including Congo, Haiti, Honduras, Iraq, Kenya, Mexico, Somalia, Sudan, Rwanda, Uganda, and Vietnam.

Crisis Outreach, including community and nationwide phone support and referrals, support for schools during a grief-related crisis, and training/resources for school staff and collaborating groups and agencies in Maine and other states.

Volunteers are at the heart of our model, including trained peer support group facilitators, and those who provide office support and make our special events successful.

Impact

- Served 400 children, teens, and adults in our bereavement peer support groups meeting in Portland.
- Served 71 children, teens, and adults through our Tender Living Care program.
- Trained 72 people to serve the Center and grief support programs nationwide.
- Conducted more than 65 educational presentations, trainings, and crisis support reaching 1,108 young people and 1,105 adults.
- Couldn't have done it without 243 volunteers who contributed 21,000 hours.



Highlights of Accomplishments

July 1, 2010-June 30, 2011

- Hosted our **2010 Fall Institute**, attended by participants from Maine and other states who we trained to provide peer support groups for bereaved families and families facing serious illness.
- Toward the goal of launching Center services within **York County** by Fall 2011, met with and mobilized community members, educators, and health professionals there.
- Trained 55 new counselors, and provided Center staff and volunteer support, for **America's Camp**, the camp held for ten years for children whose parents or siblings died as a result of the attacks of 9/11.
- Hosted, for the first time, a **Day for Survivors of Suicide Loss**, in conjunction with the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention's national day of remembrance.
- Revealed our new **Kids Crooked House** playhouse, handcrafted by a Maine-based company with help from local lumber and landscape businesses.

- Launched second year of the Center's unique bereavement peer support program for **Young Widows and Widowers**.
- Continued longtime leadership role in the **National Association of Grieving Children**, planning a three-day national symposium in Boston in July 2011.
- Raised funding and awareness for the Center through our **Swing "Fore" the Center golf tournament**, the **Maine Marathon**, the 100-plus hours WCYY radio **Markathon** by DJ Mark Curdo, our **14th Annual Auction**, our **20th Annual Pet and People Walk**, 35 rallies for **United Way of Greater Portland**, and creative **community-based fundraisers** led by generous individuals and groups.

Our Stories

When Our Phones Ring . . .

"We took calls today from two childcare centers looking for support related to the recent death of a five-year-old. . . . Phone support was requested by a school experiencing the death of a staff member. . . . The family requests help talking about what will be the changes for all of them, after the death of their mother. . . . A church asked us to work with parents and students on how to support children and friends in a time of loss. . . . Both callers were very tearful, because of deaths due to gun violence yesterday. . . ."

O.K. to be Happy

*"I found myself in completely unfamiliar territory. I had no idea what my kids needed," said a mom whose **husband died when her son was eleven and daughter was eight.***

"The Center helped me be prepared for what my children were experiencing. They actually helped me anticipate their needs. They provided resources to their schools and their counselors, making sure that everyone was working together to support my kids."

*Says her daughter, "I like going to the Center because it is teaching me that I am not different—I am not the only one who has lost their Dad. **They make you feel complete again,** even though you are missing someone important. They are teaching me it is OK to be happy."*



The Shocking Word "Cancer"

"We want to thank you for helping us when we heard the shocking word CANCER," wrote Susan.

*Describing as "exceptional" the atmosphere of the Center and its Tender Living Care (TLC) program, she called it an inviting, supportive place that her children enjoyed when **her family faced "such a scary" diagnosis,** and throughout the following year, as her husband sought treatment for renal cancer.*

*"You were there to lift us up," she said. "It turned out to be a positive experience for all of us. We always laughed and let off steam, the burden was lifted. We felt, '**Hey, we are not alone.**'"*

Protecting Sad Feelings

When seventh-grader Grace entered the Center's Multicultural Program, she often isolated herself, refused to participate, and bullied others. Gradually, she began participating in and enjoying the program. But when staff began talking about the year's program coming to an end, she regressed and became disruptive.

*Our program coordinator talked with Grace about how difficult saying goodbye can be when one **has not had "good goodbyes" in the past** or is leaving something that has become important to you. Grace also talked with her school counselor. She returned with a new approach, participated in the goodbye activities, and revealed to her group, "On the outside, I act this way because I am **protecting my sad feelings on the inside.**"*

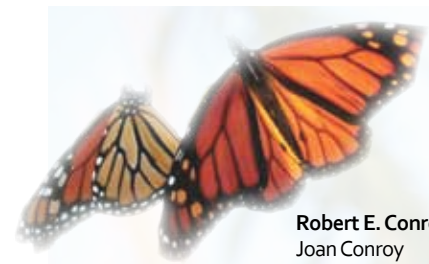

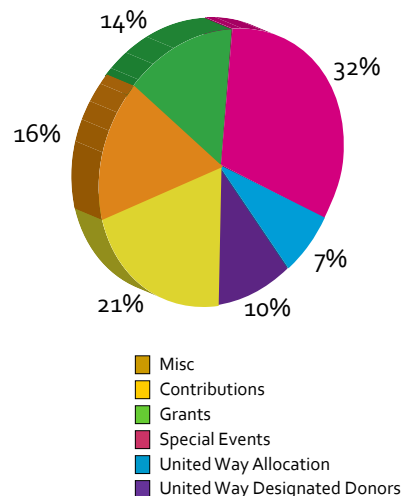

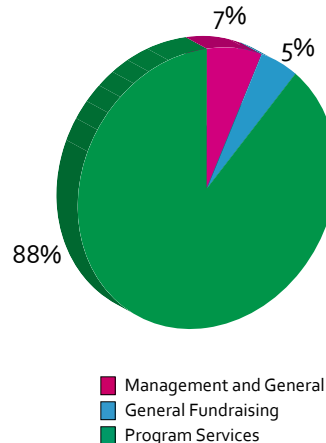
