A letter from Anne

Reflections on this past year

Dear Friends,

Another year has flown by at the Center for Grieving Children. It's almost unbelievable to think that nearly 2 ½ years have passed since our Bereavement and Tender Living Care (TLC) peer support groups moved to a virtual setting to protect our families during these unprecedented times. I continue to be astounded by the incredible creativity and adaptability our volunteer Facilitators have shown to create safe and welcoming spaces for families in these groups. Our Intercultural Program Facilitators continue to amaze me as well. So as not to contribute to the transportation shortage many schools faced this year, the program was held at each school instead of at the Center. I am also proud of our staff, trainers and consultants, board members, and donors who have once again enabled the Center to continue providing these safe spaces for grieving children and families.

Center services continue to be critical. Today, more of Maine's children are expected to experience the death of a parent or sibling by 18, now 8.4%, up from 7.5% in 2021.¹ While these estimates highlight the pandemic's early impact on our children, we are only beginning to understand its long-term effects. Despite life returning to somewhat "normal" for many, the pandemic's social isolation created a ripple effect on grief. Many who experienced the death or illness of a close family member in these past few years were unable to gather in-person with friends and family, therefore preventing life's version of the peer support model that we at the Center hold invaluable to healing.

Families are hurting. In Maine, during the first five months of 2022, the average number of people overdosing has been 792 per month, higher than 2021's already staggering monthly average of 658.2 Calls to



the Center from adults seeking support on how to talk to their child(ren) about the loss or illness of a loved one have increased in recent years from 20 to 30 minutes long. These realities assure us that the Center's work cannot stop. Our children are increasingly living these Adverse Childhood Experiences which can lead to negative consequences in how children function at school, work, and in their personal and professional relationships during childhood and into adulthood. As adults, ACEs are linked to chronic health problems, mental illness, and substance use problems. They can negatively impact education, job opportunities and earning potential. The Center strives to combat such impacts by increasing resiliency in children experiencing grief by reducing isolation, promoting hopefulness, and increasing family support through peer support, outreach and education.

Looking towards the year ahead, I am optimistic that we will continue making inroads in helping children on their grief journey. The Center continues to be the only organization of its kind in Maine providing TLC and Bereavement peer support programming in a yearround family model because the better parents cope, the better off children are. We look forward to returning to in-person peer support groups in Portland and Sanford, and expect to keep one night of Bereavement services virtual. This will not only increase the Center's ability to serve bereaved children and families who live in more remote parts of Maine, but this option will bring down barriers for southern Maine residents who, for a variety of reasons, may prefer virtual groups over in-person. To support this hybrid approach to services, however, the need for volunteer Facilitators is higher than ever before.

It is my hope that you will continue supporting Center programming in the many ways possible so families can continue accessing support at no cost, for as long as needed, regardless of a family's income level or insurance coverage. No child should grieve alone, and your support helps ensure we can stay true to that goal.





Bereavement Program

Providing grief support in our Portland and Sanford locations, and virtually for children, teens, their parents, families, young adults and bereaved parents and widows/widowers/ partners. Thanks to virtual delivery of our Bereavement peer support services, we've welcomed families into groups typically unable to attend on-site services, perhaps because they live in rural Maine or experience other barriers, such as transportation issues or time to commute. This has shaped the Center's priority to make the Bereavement program hybrid, offering service nights in Portland and Sanford, as well as online.

This past year, we welcomed B. Hailey onto our team who will coordinate additional night of online service starting with Young Widow/Widower/ Partners and Young Adult groups. B. holds a master's in social work with a certificate in Trauma-Informed Care and has been a welcome member to our compassionate and welltrained program team!










Welcome Danielle!

Danielle is responsible for providing outreach, family and community support, and leading the bereavement night of service in York County. Danielle began her work with the Center as a group facilitator in 2012 and was most recently a Team Coordinator since 2018 until joining Center staff this past year as a Bereavement Services Coordinator. Danielle holds a bachelor's degree in Social Work from the University of Southern Maine and we are so thrilled to welcome her into the Center family!







"We came to the Center last year after our grandfather died. The Center has been really helpful. Just to be able to talk about it and have people there to help you with it. And the people are there because they can relate to what you're going through. At first, we weren't sure how it would be. But we started going and it just helped us and made us feel better. We were very shy but as we got used to our groups, it felt like a home. Everyone was so kind and inviting. It's great to have kids there who can relate to you and are the same age.

Our Facilitators are super, super kind and they don't push you to say anything. They just let you take your time to get to know everyone. They're super friendly and they know what you're going through as well. They're easy to talk to, once you

see a change in how we were handling our loss, and it was just good to know that my brother and I go there and that now we can talk about it together after."



Helping children, teens, young adults, parents, and caregivers with the changes that come with a family member's diagnosis of serious illness. Support is available from point of diagnosis and at every step along their journey with the illness.





"When I was diagnosed with my condition and found out I needed major life-saving surgery, I reached out to a lot of people who may have been able to help my son through this challenge. The one that stuck long-term was the TLC program at the Center for Grieving Children. It warmed my heart to learn how much they really, truly care.

The TLC program has given me the opportunity to have unique accountability partners: when I know I am going to report my progress, I am likely to aim for the very best. The program is filled with folks who understand many aspects of recovering from a major surgery, while parenting. The kind people who help with the groups are phenomenal as well. They provide a caring environment, each and every time. My son Mica and I have benefited greatly from the comradery of the groups, and always look forward to our next meeting, no matter where we are or what we're doing.

FOR FAMILIES FACING LIFE-IMPACTING ILLNESS

"I have been part of the TLC program for 14 years. As a young mother, my family was impacted by illness and our support was limited. Recognizing the challenges of that time, it's important that I offer to families what was not available to mine.

The role of TC is expansive. It requires, among other things, the ability to listen to and hold the feelings of many different people, as well as to support and guide facilitators in their work. The partnership forged with our staff person and my fellow TC is imperative. It's a bond built on kindness and trust. Without this it would be impossible to sustain my work in TLC.

If I could share one bit of wisdom, it would be to recognize that you are not alone in your role, but rather part of a community that joins together for the purpose of helping others. And in the words of the ancient poet, Rumi: "The inspiration you seek is within you. Be silent and listen."

Intercultural Program


Creating healing communities, the Center's Intercultural Program is for children and teens resettled in Maine from countries that have experienced war, violent conflict, and natural disaster, in collaboration with Portland Public schools. At 25 years old, this program is the oldest of its kind in the U.S.

Our Intercultural Programming was an amazing success with the program taking place at three Portland Public middle schools, including Lyman Moore, Lincoln, and King.







